Dee Pringle

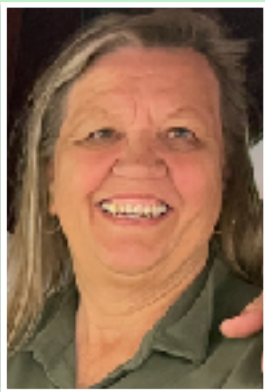
Hello Alfa Family! This is Dee Pringle and I have agreed to offer my time and energy to the office of Secretary.
